



MONDAY MORNING WINS: HISTORIC INVESTMENT, BORDER SECURITY

There's nothing better than starting the week with a pair of major victories for the American people — all made possible by the leadership of President Donald J. Trump.

Apple's \$500 billion investment: Apple CEO Tim Cook <u>announced</u> today that the company will invest \$500 billion in the United States over the next four years amid President Trump's tariffs push. The historic venture, which comes

following Cook's <u>meeting</u> with President Trump last week, will <u>result</u> in 20,000 new U.S.-based jobs and was immediately <u>hailed</u> as a "landmark" step in bringing back U.S. manufacturing.

It's another watershed moment in President Trump's commitment to usher in the new Golden Age of America. In just over a month, President Trump has <u>announced</u> a \$500 billion private sector investment for the largest artificial intelligence infrastructure project in history, a <u>commitment</u> by Saudi Arabia to invest \$600 billion in the U.S. over the next four years, a <u>\$20 billion investment</u> by DAMAC Properties to build new U.S.-based data centers, a <u>pledge</u> by Taiwan to boost U.S.-based investment, and a <u>major investment</u> by Nippon Steel. Mercedes-Benz also <u>announced</u> plans to "<u>grow</u>" its vehicle production in the U.S.



Illegal immigrants turn around: <u>New reporting</u> says would-be illegal border crossers have "given up" and are returning to their own countries — citing the Trump Administration's unprecedented crackdown on illegal immigration, including the <u>shutdown</u> of the "CBP One" app, as the driving factor. It's a victory for national security after four years of open borders. In President Trump's first month back in office, illegal border crossings hit <u>lows not seen in</u> <u>decades</u> — <u>down 94% over last year</u>, while <u>interior arrests are up 134%</u>.
